Overview

The **Apple Developer Account Enrollment Guide** covers the process of the Apple Developer account creation and enrollment.

If the users want to make their apps available on the App Store, then they have to log in with their Apple Id and enroll their **Apple Developer Account** in the Apple Developer Program. If the users do not have the Apple Id, then they have to create the new one.

The Apple Developer Program provides everything that the users need to build and distribute their apps to Apple customers around the world. The paid Apple Developer Account is used to sideload apps on the iPhone, iPad, and Apple TV, and also to deploy apps to the App Store.

The users can use the Apple Developer account to test their apps on their registered devices.

Tip 💡 : **Sideload**, intends installing an application package available in the APK format on an Android device.

Create Apple ID

Before enrollment the users have to create an Apple ID. Using the account, the users can submit more than one application.

To create Apple Id

- 1) Go to the <https://developer.apple.com/register/> link.

A dialog box appears as shown in the **Figure 1**.

- 2) In the **Apple ID** box, enter a value to represent as an Id.

- 3) In the **Password** box, enter a password.
- 4) Click the **Create Apple ID** button.

The page appears as shown in the Figure 2.

- 5) Click the **Continue** button.

A verification email is sent and a **Verification** dialog box appears as shown in the Figure 3.

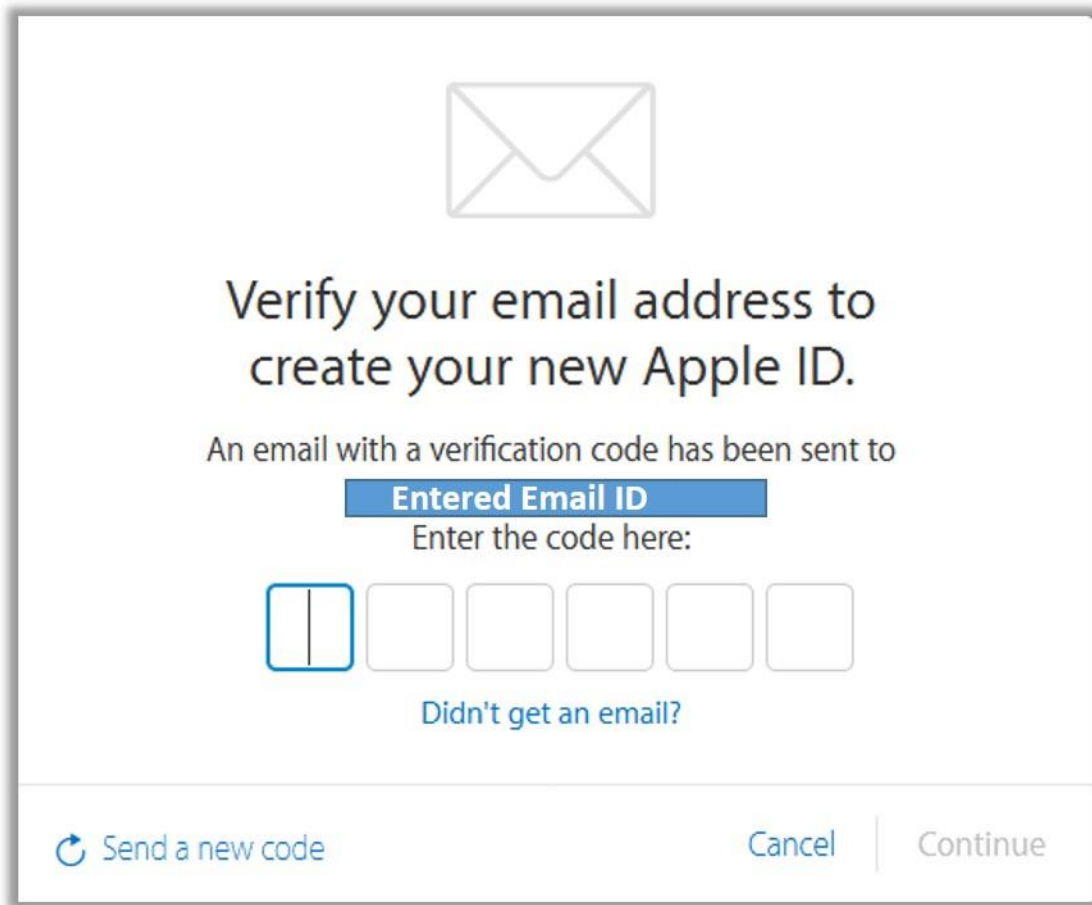

- 6) Enter the provided code.

The Continue button is activated.

- 7) Click the **Continue** button.

The Apple Developer Account is created.

Enroll Apple Developer Program

After the Apple ID is created, the users can enroll their Apple Developer Program. To list the company name as the seller on the App Store, the company must be recognized as a legal entity in its country.

The cost of enrollment is 99 USD per membership year. Prices may vary from region to region and are listed in the local currency during the enrollment process.

Membership includes access to beta OS releases, advanced app capabilities, and tools to develop, test, and distribute apps and Safari extensions.

Users can enroll as follows:

- **An individual:** If users enroll as an individual or sole proprietor or single person business, who is interested in creating apps for distribution on the App Store for iPhone, iPad, Mac, and Apple Watch, then the user can sell apps on the App Store using their personal name. The users need to provide basic personal information, including their legal name and address.
- **A company or organization:** If users enroll as an organization, who is interested in creating apps for distribution on the App Store for iPhone, iPad, Mac, and Apple Watch, then the users as an organization can sell apps on the App store using their legal entity name.

The users have to fulfill the following requirements for the enrollment as an organization:

- **A D-U-N-S® Number:** The organization must have a D-U-N-S Number so that Apple can verify the identity of the organization and legal entity status. These unique nine-digit numbers are assigned by Dun and Bradstreet and are widely used as standard business identifiers. Check if the organization already has a D-U-N-S Number and request one, if necessary. They are free in most jurisdictions.
- **Legal Entity Status:** The organization must be a legal entity, so that it can register legal agreements with Apple. Apple do not accept DBAs, fictitious business, trade names, or branches. The legal entity name must correspond with tax ID that the organization plan to use and appears as the seller for apps available for the distribution on the App Store.
- **Legal Binding Authority:** As a person enrolling the organization in the Apple Developer Program, the user must have the legal authority to bind the organization to legal agreements. The user must be the owner or founder of the organization, executive team member, senior project lead, or have a legal authority granted by a senior employee.

To enroll Apple Developer Program

- 1) Go to the <https://developer.apple.com/enroll/> link.
- 2) Click the **Start Your Enrollment** button.

A dialog box appears as shown in the **Figure 4**.

- 3) In the **Apple ID** box, enter the Apple Id.
- 4) In the **Password** box, enter the password.
- 5) Click the **Sign In** button.

The page appears as shown in the **Figure 5**.

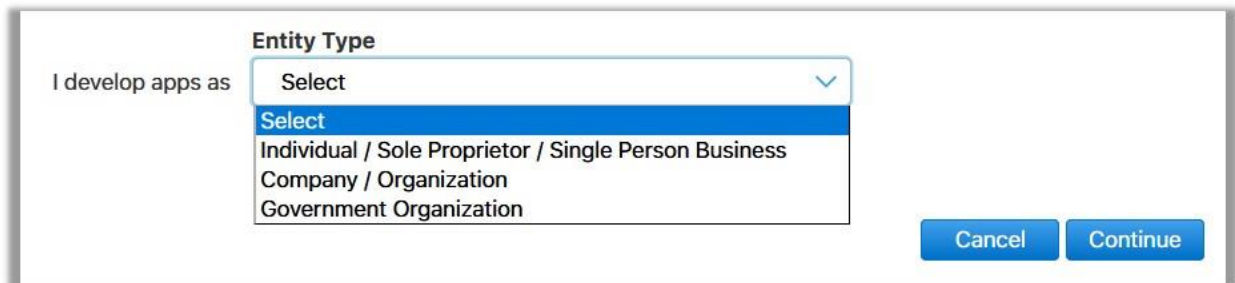


- 6) In the **Entity Type** list, select the required option.

Note: If the users selects **Individual / Sole Proprietor / Single Person Business**, then a Note appears as shown in the **Figure 6**.


Please note: In order for your company name to be listed as the seller on the App Store, your company must be recognized as a legal entity in your country. Sole proprietors and single person companies located in countries where they are not recognized as legal entities will be enrolled and be listed for download under the enrollee's personal legal name, if selected for distribution by Apple.

- 10) Select the check box, and agree to the license agreement.
- 11) Click the **Continue** button.

Once the enrollment information is verified and the users are agreed to the associated program license agreement, they can purchase their membership.

- 12) Enter the payment details to complete the purchase on the Apple Online Store.

Once the purchase is completed, a purchase confirmation from the Apple Online Store and an activation confirmation from Apple Developer Program Support is sent to the user through email.

- 13) Check the email and enter the verification link sent in email.

The account is activated.

Tip 💡 : To check the status of your enrollment, sign in to your [account](#) on the developer website with the Apple ID you used to enroll.

Register A New Device

The user can add multiple devices in the team. The user can test the app only on registered devices.

To register a new device

- 1) Go to the <https://developer.apple.com/account/ios/device/deviceCreate.action> link.

A dialog box appears as shown in the **Figure 4**.

- 2) In the **Apple ID** box, enter the Apple Id.
- 3) In the **Password** box, enter the password.
- 4) Click the **Sign In** button.

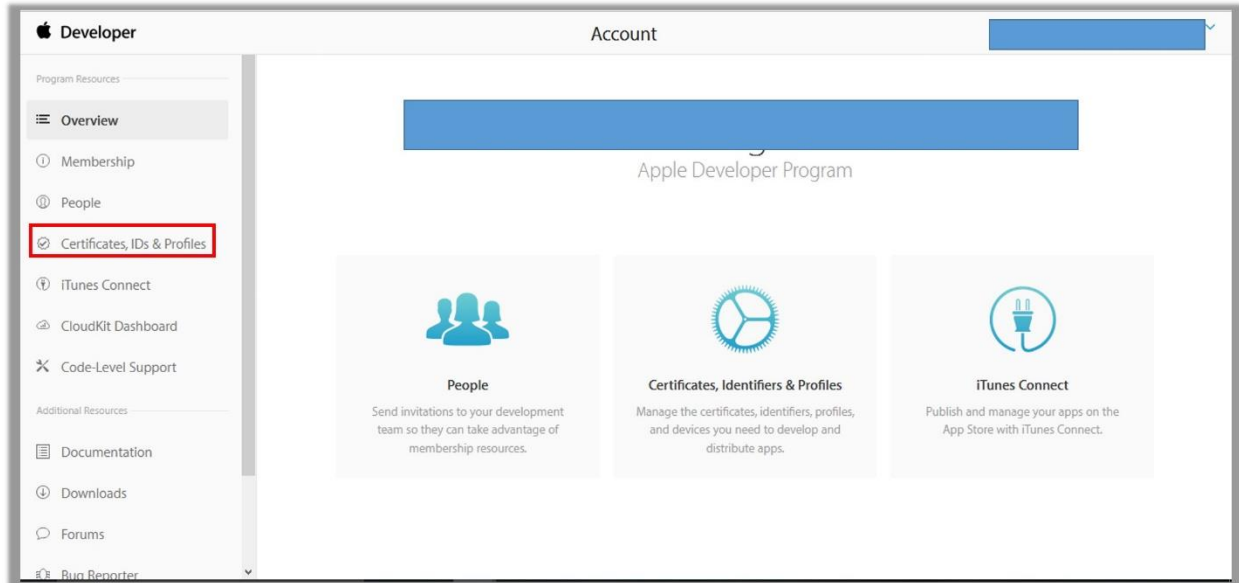

The **Certificates, Identifiers & Profiles** page appears as shown in the **Figure 11**.

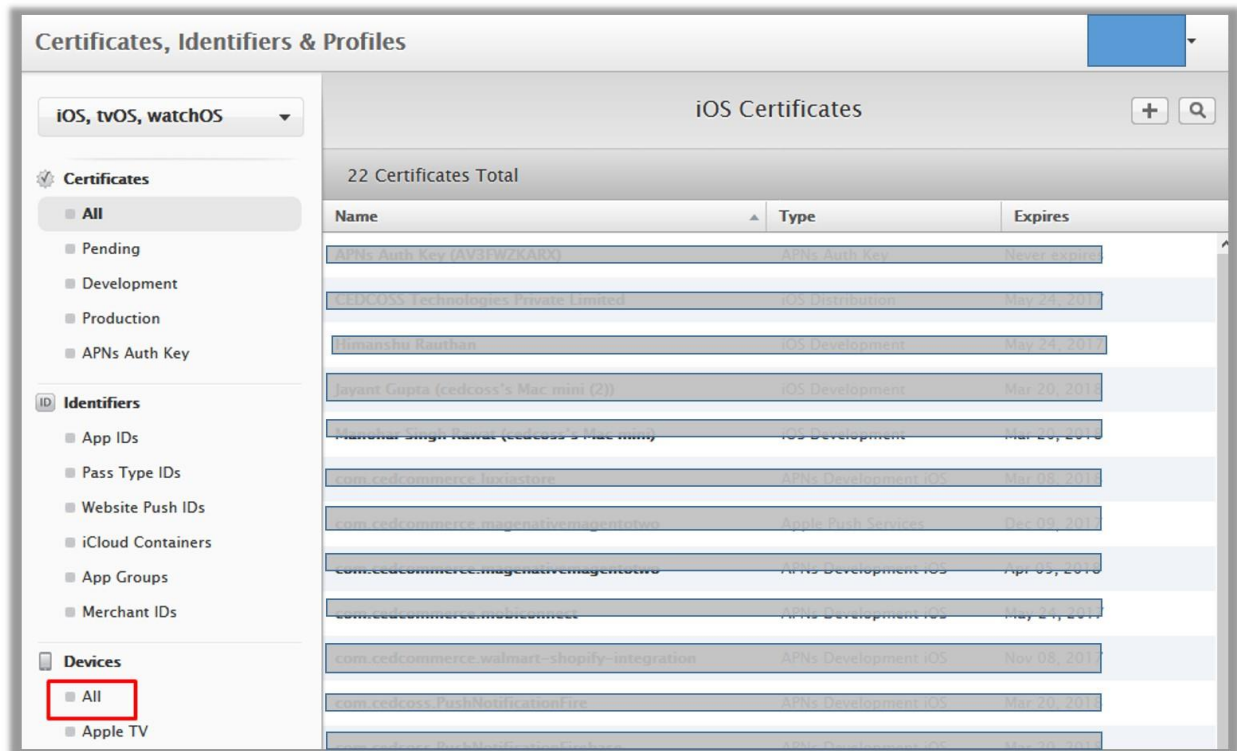

The page appears as shown in the **Figure 12**.

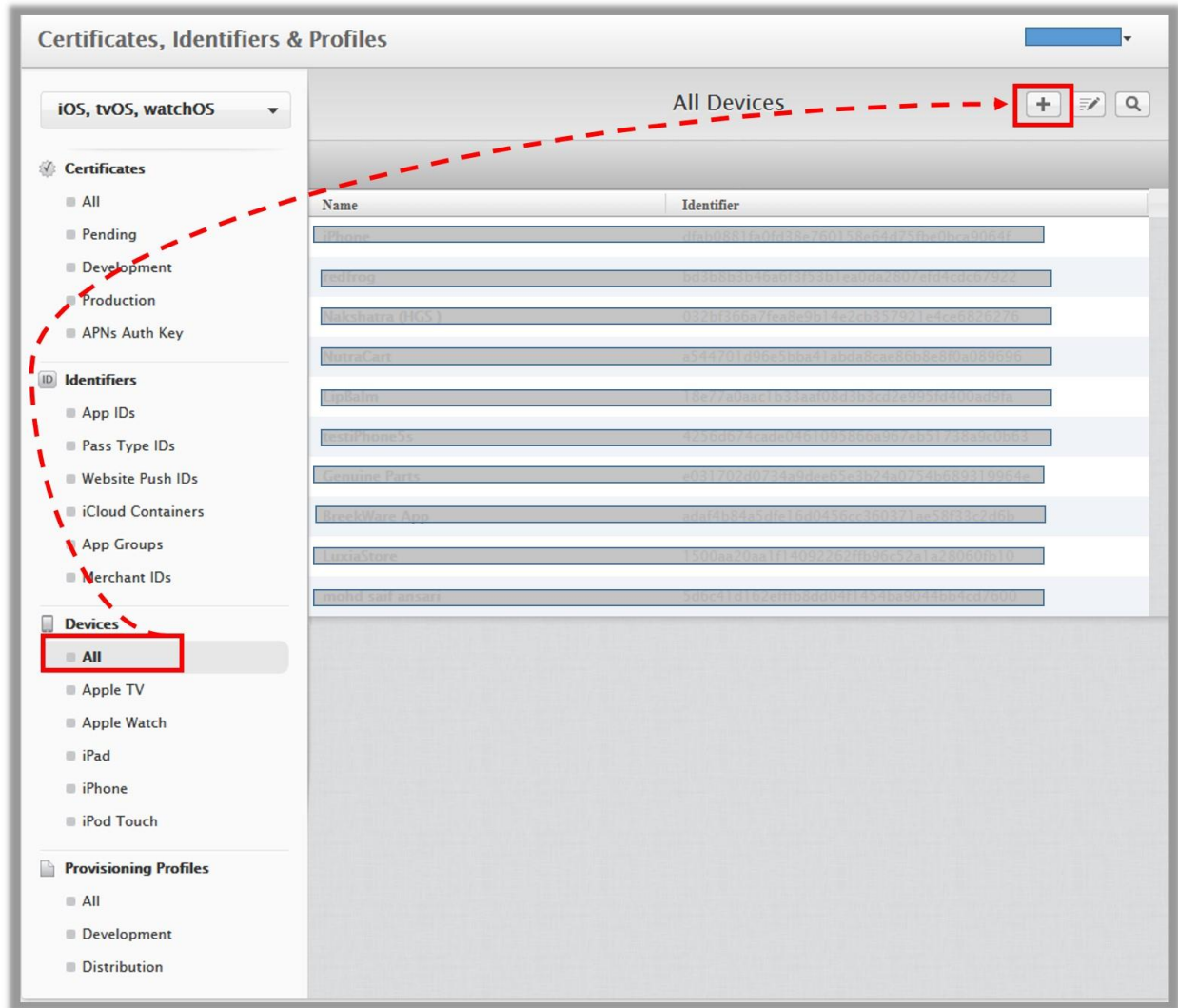

7) In the upper-right corner, click the plus  icon.

The page appears as shown in the **Figure 13**.

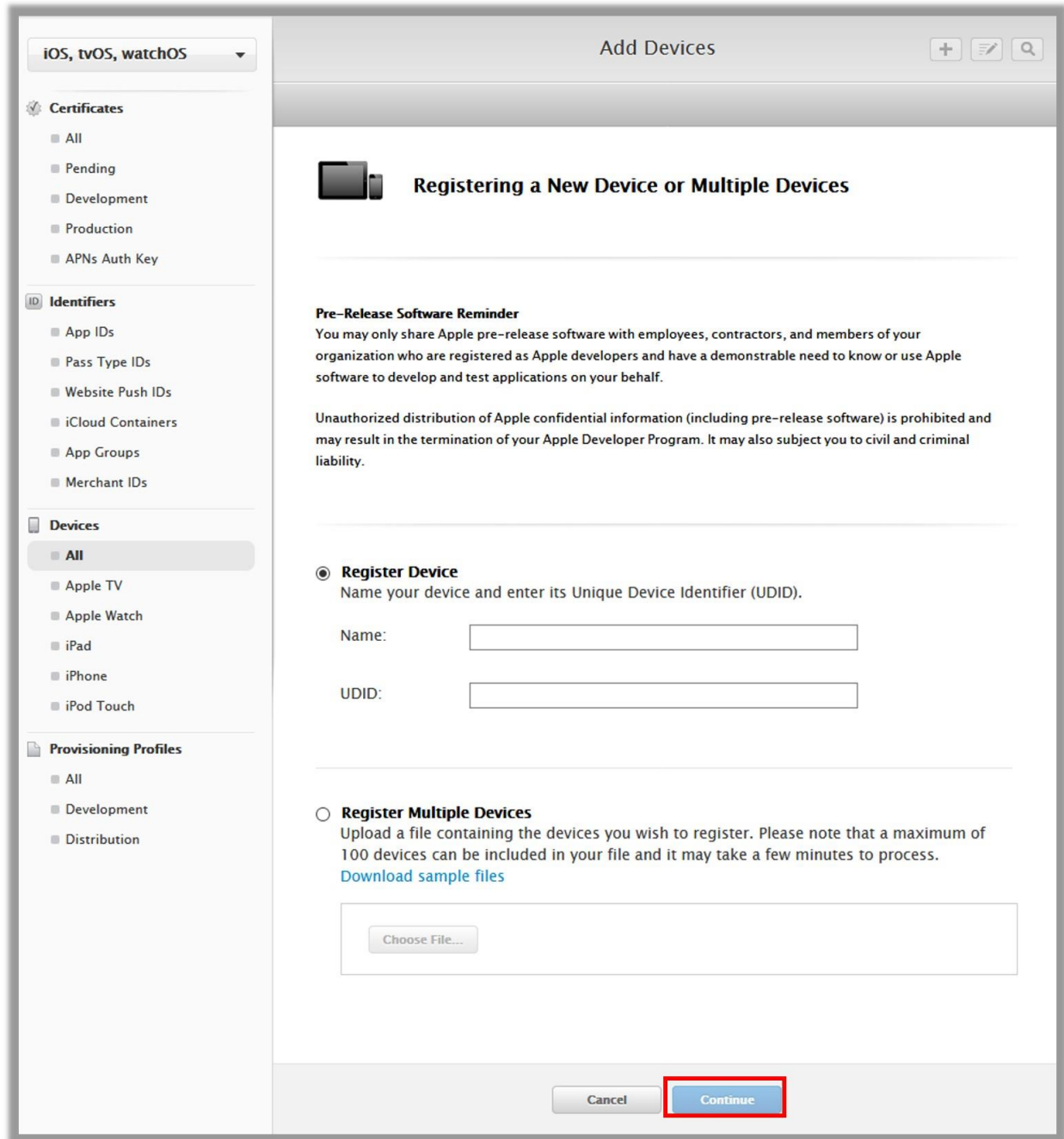

- 8) In the right panel, under **Register Device**, do the following:
 - a) In the **Name** box, enter the name of the device.
 - b) In the **UDID** box, enter the Unique Device Identifier (UDID) of the device.
- 9) Click the **Continue** button.

Another page appears.
- 10) Click the **Register** button.

The Device is registered.

How to find the UDID

While following the device registration process, the user has to enter the UDID number of the device.

To find the UDID of a device

- 1) Connect the iPhone to a computer using USB, and then launch iTunes.

The page appears as shown in the **Figure 14**.

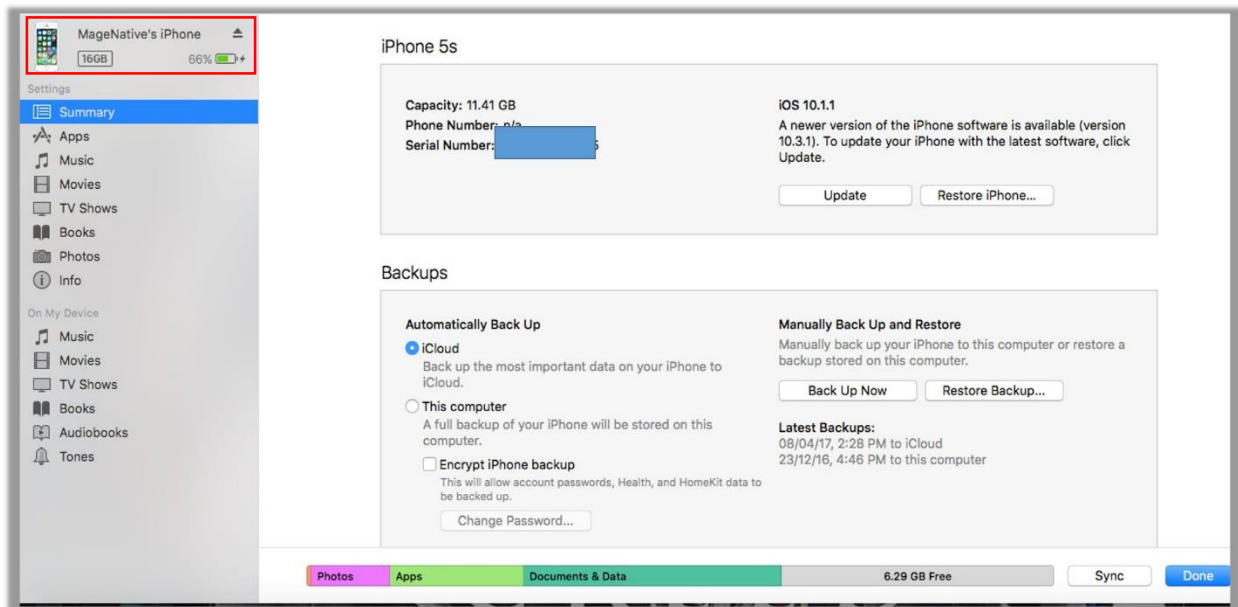

- 2) In the upper-left corner, select the required iPhone.
- 3) On the left navigation menu, click **Summary**.
- 4) In the right panel, click the serial number of the device to display the UDID.

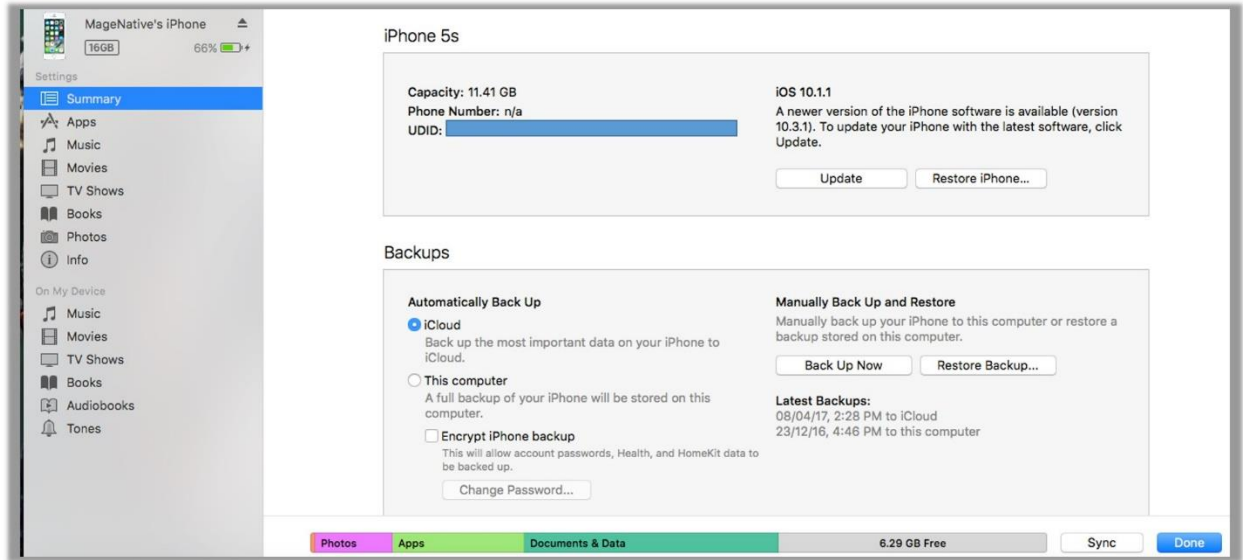
